### rattan stains

clear coat



will accentuate the natural markings of the rattan. The joinery and putty will also be visible. Because rattan is a natural vine, every piece is different.

vintage cane



will add an overall glaze of honey-amber tone to the piece. The tonal variation of the rattan will still be visible, while the joinery and putty will be a little more subtle.

medium tortoise



our newest addition is both a bit lighter tortoise and a bit more traditional. While opaque, you still see the characteristic nodes of the material.

dark tortoise



is our classic version that designers come back to year after year. While opaque, you still see the characteristic nodes of the material.

dark roast

rub



is a hand rubbed ebony revealing amber tones of rattan underneath. An overall opaque finish, the nodes of the material are still visible.
